ORDER

As per the Govt Order read above, sanction was accorded for the implementation of the Pilot Project. Bridging the Digital Divide, (Akshaya) at an estimated cost of Rs 150. Lakhs, (iw), in Malappuram and Thiruvananthapuram Districts: It was also ordered that the Project would be implemented with the active participation of Panchayath Raj institutions, NGOs and private Sector in the State.

The Director KSITM in his letter read as second paper above has informed that the State Level Executive Committee of AKSHAYA has proposed to associate Government agencies like STED for Entrepreneur Training and Support, IKM for animator training and Support, C-DIT for preparation of Literacy Training, ER&DC for Technical Support, Town Planning for Location issues, Govern IT for web based support and PRD for awareness campaign. The Committee has also approved a total outlay of Rs 1141 lakhs for the pilot projects including the contribution of Rs 720 lakhs from the Local Bodies. As the cost share of KSITM is to be limited to Rs 150 lakhs for which Administrative Sanction was issued by Govt, the Director KSITM has forwarded an Estimate appended as Annexure A amounting to Rs. 150 lakhs and requested to approve the estimate.

After having examined the proposal, Govt are pleased to approve the AKSAYA Project Estimate appended as Annexure A, amounting to Rs 150 lakhs (Rupees One Hundred and Fifty lakhs) for the proper implementation of Bridging the Digital Divide (AKSHAYA) Project in Malappuram and Thiruvananthapuram District.

The Director KSITM shall ensure that the expenditure is incurred subject to availability of Budget provision and on merits of various Schemes.
