ORDER

As per the Government Order read as first paper above sanction was accorded for the implementation of Bridging the Digital Divide Project (AKSHAYA) in the State. Malappuram and Thiruvananthapuram Districts were identified as Pilot districts for the implementation of the AKSHAYA Project and the estimated project cost was Rs 150 lakhs. The Director Kerala State IT Mission in his letter read as second paper above has requested that the period of implementation of the Project may be extended till November 2003 in Malappuram District with an additional expenditure of Rs 51.30 lakhs as stated below.

a) Block Level Co-ordination	Rs. 5.00 lakhs
b) Local Body Level Coordination	Rs. 6.30 lakhs
c) Project Office Monitoring	Rs. 15.00 lakhs
d) Campaign	<u>Rs. 25.00 lakhs</u>

The Director, Kerala State IT Mission has also requested to accord Administrative Sanction to implement the Pilot Project AKSHAYA at Malappuram District for the extended period of six months till November, 2003, at an estimated cost of Rs. 51.31 lakhs.
