The National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) aims to make all Government Services accessible to the common man in his locality, through Common Service delivery outlets and ensure efficiency, transparency and reliability of such services at affordable costs to realize the basic needs of the common man. In order to ensure the delivery of services, to the citizen effectively and quickly there is need to build the State Service Delivery Gateway (SSDG) and State Portal (SP). The State Portal is envisioned as the information interactive, integrated and trusted service delivery channel for all the G2C and G2B services of the State and its Constituent Departments.

As envisaged in the DIT guidelines, the Director, Kerala State IT Mission has been designated as the nodal agency as per the GO read as 2nd paper above to implement the State Portal and SSDG and as per the GO read as 4th paper above an Apex Committee headed by Chief Secretary has been constituted for implementation of the programme in the State.

Avid Relston Now the DIT, GOI have issued administrative approval for the project to be implemented by Kerala State IT Mission at a total estimated outlay of Rs.1552.92 lakhs over a period of 4 years. DIT contribution is Rs.776.46 lakhs which would be released as Grant-in-Aid to be met from e-Governance Head and Rs.776.46 lakhs to be met through ACA for NeGP provision of Planning Commission.

In the above circumstances Government are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the deployment of State Portal(SP) and State Service Delivery Gateway(SSDG) as part of the national e-Governance Programme in the State.
