ORDER

In addition to the existing Data Centre, a new State Data Centre is being set up in the State Under National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) of the Government of India. Government of India have formulated the guidelines to provide Technical and Financial assistance to the States for setting up SDC. SDC implementation is a time bound activity and therefore it is important to focus on the key issues and mile stones for effective and efficient Project Management of SDC. As per the guidelines issued in this regard the overall management control of SDC shall be with the State Government, the day to day operations of the Data Centre shall be the responsibility of the Data Centre Project Manager As per para 6-2 of the guidelines the cost of manpower required for domain specialist team for Data Centre Operation and Management over a period of five years shall be provided by Government of India. Accordingly, the Director, KSITM in his letter read as second paper above has forwarded a proposal for formation of a PMU for SDC.

Government have examined the proposal of the Director, KSITM in detail in the light of the guidelines issued by Government of India in this regard and are pleased to accord sanction for the formation of a Programme Management Unit (PMU) for SDC for the State with the following staff pattern, subject to the condition that the discontinuing of the staff will be considered after 5 years.
