## <u>ORDER</u>

As per GO read as first paper above Government have appointed M/s Keltron as a full time agency to provide necessary support for implementing the digital work flow software MESSAGE in Secretariat. Accordingly they have submitted proposal for implemening the MESSAGE in seven Departmements viz Information Technology, Food & Civil Supplies, Public Works, Higher Education, Finance, NORKA and Co-operation. As per GO read as second paper above a Technical Committee was constituted to study the proposal. Based on the revised proposals submitted by M/s Keltron, Technical Committee recommended for accepting the proposal. As per GO read as third paper above Administraive Sanction to the tune of Rs245 lakhs have been accorded for the implementation in above seven Departments. During implementation it was found that the MESSAGE lacks scalability, security, encryption, Unicode support, MIS, and user friendliness. Accordingly it was decided to re-engineer the software to make a fully compatable digial work flow for Secretariat environment and thus Digital Document & Filing System (DDFS) was developed. It is in J2EE platform and MySQL DB with extensive auditing and logging capabilities and Unicode support. It is integrated with IBM digitisation server to maintain the closed files and easy interface for scanning with support for SANE protocol. As per GO read as fifth paper above Government have prescribed change of operations during implementation of DDFS. In the Gos read as 6th ,7th

and 8<sup>th</sup> the responsibilities and privilages of different users were prescribed. As per GO read as 9<sup>th</sup> paper above procedure for adminstration of DDFS is defined. As per GOs read as 4<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> above necessary back-up and disaster recovery plan were formulated. All the arrangements perscribed above were completed and hence the Digital Work Flow DDFS will be started in Information Technology Departement from 15<sup>th</sup> December 2010. All the file processing in Information Technology Departement will be electronoic from that date and Government orders accordingly.
